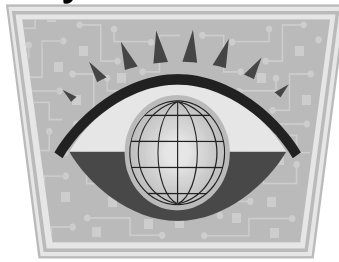


# CyberVision

## CyberVision Guidelines

TechACCESS's CyberVision is to be a relaxing, enjoyable, environment where every individual is respected and acknowledged. Inappropriate behavior and disrespectful language will not be tolerated. Participants may be asked not to return if behavior persists.

- If there are less than 5 students signed up, TechACCESS reserves the right to cancel the session.
- CyberVision is limited to 18 participants. This could change due to available supervision and/or program.
- Priority will be given to RI students
- Participants may bring their own equipment to CyberVision. However, TechACCESS cannot be responsible if equipment is broken, lost or stolen
- No inappropriate materials may be loaded on your computer including pirated media, and objectionable content.
- Parents and guardians are welcome to stay. Those who do not stay must provide emergency contact information and be at TechACCESS promptly at end of program
- Guests are welcome at the discretion of the Program Coordinator with advanced notification.
- Pizza lunch is provided. Program Coordinator must be made aware of food allergies at time of registration.
- Regretfully we do not have the staff for personal care assistants. If a person uses a PCA, the PCA must remain on site for the duration of the program.
